

Tropical Cyclone Guba almost stationary

The weather bureau says Tropical Cyclone Guba, off the far north Queensland coast, is almost stationary.

The category one cyclone is 380 kilometres north of the Cape York community of Lockhart River.

It is the first cyclone this season and the first to occur in November since 1977.

Cairns forecaster Alicia Duncanson says the system is expected to move south today.

"It hasn't moved very much, it's still very erratic, almost stationary, moving north-west at about four kilometres per hour, so they're not moving very quickly," she said.

"It's still expected to intensify, but rather slowly. Probably not expecting it to get to a category two for the next day or two."
