

Cyclone Guba intensifying on move south

Tropical Cyclone Guba has changed direction and is now moving slowly south through the Coral Sea.

The category one storm is around 400 kilometres north-east of Lockhart River on eastern Cape York.

Ann Farrell from the Cyclone Warning Centre says Guba is expected to slowly intensify as it moves south overnight.

"We're not expecting it to have any impact on coastal communities in the next 24 hours but should it start to track west in that subsequent period we are maintaining that watch for Thursday Island to Cape Flattery," she said.
